S. Lee Ager grew up in a creative family which included painters, a commercial artist, and a fashion illustrator. This milieu of artistic activity was a catalyst for her own creativity. An art teacher encouraged her and arranged for her to attend art classes at the private Kingswood School in Bloomfield Hills, MI. This early enriching experience helped define the career she would one day pursue.

Ager received a B.S. degree from Wayne State University and a M.A. degree from Eastern Michigan University. After years of working as an art teacher and as a commercial artist, Ager made the leap to become a full-time fine artist. She has exhibited her oil paintings in many juried and invitational shows, including a number of one-woman shows. She has won a variety of top awards, including "Best of Show."

The artist's paintings are in several public locations and in many private collections across the country. Ager's artwork has also been the subject of two television programs that focused on her Michigan lakes' area landscapes and her series of paintings about the Detroit Eastern Market.
