



## Jeanne Hyland

### A Passion for Nature's Beauties

Just as a powerful roaring rapid shoots off into a different direction when giant boulders are in its path, so did Jeanne Hyland's career as a professional sculptor change in 2002. Breast cancer causing limited strength and motion, threw Jeanne out of her stream of life – clay and bronze sculpting. When she adopted watercolor as her new medium, it took like a fish to water. She has now put her dimensional, sculptural sensibilities to work creating unique, close-up flowers and portraits. Jeanne's artwork combines the love of nature's beauty, energy, and forms with an intense palette and technical skill. Through the change in mediums, her career as an artist has transformed and accelerated, while her passion for the figure and form has remained constant.



Jeanne's artistic expression started early by graduating with a BFA (magna cum laude) from the University of New Hampshire in sculpture and drawing. She went on to study at the Ecole des Beaux Arts in France. After years in the commercial design world in Colorado, she was returning to her Fine Art roots and passion for sculpting. Ms. Hyland currently teaches two "Journeys Through Watercolor" classes at the Brand Library Studios in Glendale, CA, and she will be instructing at the LA Academy of Figurative Art spring 2007. She is included in the recent International Artist Publishing book: How Did You Paint That? 100 ways to paint still life and florals Vol. II. ([www.international-artist.com](http://www.international-artist.com)). Her sculpture was also published in Art•Rage•Us, the Art & Outrage of Breast Cancer (Chronicle Books) and was part of the educational, touring show for 4 years.

Most recently Jeanne's paintings have been in the National Watercolor Society's Annual All Member Show, Watercolor West XXXVIII, garnered 2 awards for portraits in last spring's Valley Watercolor Society's Annual Show, and received the Anna Drobnies Award in the San Diego Watercolor Society's 26th International Exhibition. She has twice exhibited at the Descanso Botanical Gardens. Jeanne Hyland is a signature member of Women Artists of the West (inducted as a sculptor), currently a Board Member of the National Watercolor Society, and a member of American Watercolor Society, Watercolor West, California Watercolor Association, Valley Watercolor Society, and Pasadena Society of Artists.
